AUTHOR GUIDE LINES OF SOCIAL SCIENCE RESEARCH REVIEW PAPER USING KEYWORD SEQUENCE IMPORTANCE (KSI) MODULE

Key word: 5- 6 using words. IVs, DV(s), Methods, Context

Abstract

Introductory importance (3-4 lines)

Summarize findings of major 4-5 DV(s), no numerical value (6-8 lines)

Hypothetical Future Recommendation (3-4 lines)

Significance and contribution

Introduction

Background: 15-20 citations (respondent citations-3, Independent variable citations 3-4, dependent variable 10-12).

Research problem or gap (respondent, Independent variable, dependent variable), total citations number - 120-150, 4-6 Figure/sketch related social factors

Objectives of the review: Two Lines

Importance of the study: 4-5 lines

Conclusion: 2 Lines

Literature Review

Present existing theories, models, and findings (10-15 citations)

Use recent and high-quality sources (journals, indexed databases) 10 – 20 citations

Organize thematically or chronologically

Compare and contrast studies (Agreements, Contradictions, Trends)

Use tables/figures if necessary

Conceptual grouping of literature (Identification of research gaps)

Discussion

Interpret synthesised findings (10 citations)

Link with theory and practice (15 citations)

Highlight implications: (Academic, Managerial, Policy)

Conclusion

Summary of key insights: repeated citations 10 to 20 citations

Contribution of the study: 5 to 10 citations

Limitations: 4-6 citations

Directions for future research (4-5 lines)

NB: Format Time New Roman, 12 font

Respondent citation length (1-2 lines): Rice farmers like to adopt Agro technology as a solution to promote sustainable Agricultural System (Pello et al 2021).

Independent variable citation length (1-2 lines): eg, Rice farmers accepted the technology as a solution to promote sustainable Agriculture due to good knowledge (Pello, et al 2021).

Dependent Variable Citation Length for the Introduction Part (2-3 lines)

eg, Majority of the farmers good performance Agro technology as a solution to a sustainable Agricultural system due to their level of knowledge (Pello, et al 2021)

Dependent variable citation length for discussion part (2-3 lines): 50 % of the farmers good performance Agroforestry technology as a solution to sustainable Agricultural system due to their level of awareness (Pello, et al 2021)
